- Third party race pack collections will be allowed for this event, if you are sending someone to collect on your behalf, please ensure they bring:
 - A letter from you giving permission for them to collect on your behalf. (****Please include their ID and your ID number in the letter.***)
 - A copy or photo of your ID / driver's license as well as their own ID / driver's license

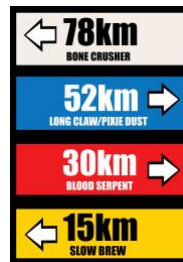
DURING YOUR RACE

Route Maps

- Download your route map [here](#).
- **Please Note:** Each route is colour coded, so take note of the colour of the distance category that you have entered. This will be important for following route split points and directional signage on route.

Signage

- **Split Points:** Please look out for split boards, pictured below and know your route colour to avoid following the wrong route.



- **Route Markers:** These markers will be placed at multiple points on your route as confirmation that you are on the right path.

Equipment

- **Devil Thorns galore!** Tubeless tyres or sludge filled tubes are compulsory. It is currently devil thorn season and without the right tyres you won't be able to make it passed the start line.
- This is a helmet compulsory race, no helmet, no race.
- All routes cover a mixture of gravel road, jeep track and single track and are therefore not suitable for road bikes.

Whilst there are numerous hydration points on route - please ensure you plan your hydration and have ample water on your bike also know where your hydration points are along your race route.

Timing & Results

- DBX is happy to announce the appointment of [FinishTime](#) as our timing service provider for 2019.
- **Race Rules**
 - Winners will be determined by fastest race time and not first across the line.

- A start and finish mat will ensure results will reflect your actual race time
- Seeding will be done through [S.A.Seeding](#). You will be assigned a batch start group during race week, which will be confirmed with your race number collection on the official registration days before race day. If you prefer to ride with a partner in another batch start group, the stronger rider will need to drop back to join the other rider in the later start time.
- E-bikes are allowed at DBX 2019. If you intend to ride the event using an e-bike, please let us know before Friday 17 May 2019. This is to ensure you are assigned to the correct batch and included in the e-bike category. Please note that e-bikers are not eligible for the prize-money.
- **Disputes**
 - A race referee will be present on race day to verify all official results.
 - Riders will have 30mins post race to dispute podium results after they have been released, no disputes will be entered into once the prize-giving has begun post the 30 min window. Prize-giving will take place following the verification of the results by the race referee at least 10 – 15min after any disputes have been resolved.
- **Results**
 - Provisional Results will be live and immediately available on <https://results.finishtime.co.za/>
 - Participants will receive their provisional finish time via SMS moments after crossing the finish line. SMS's will be sent to the number provided during registration so please ensure all contact details are correct when entering/registering.
 - Printed provisional results will also be available on the results board at the information booth in the race village should you not have access to internet or your cellphone.
- **Prize Purse**
 - There will be a prize purse of R24 000
